








Dataset produced during the past 5 years













Applied data collection method



















Type of stored data


















Current access to data v.s. ideal level of access











Willingness to provide research data to archive, provided that data would be safely preserved and access regulated






Importance of sharing the data






Better access to data as benefit for scientific work


